



Community service is very important at School of the Nations. Teachers and students are encouraged to get involved with supporting the needs of Macau and the region. Form 5 students take an international service trip every year as part of their Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) requirements for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. Teachers at all levels find ways to incorporate service learning into the curriculum with typical activities being blood drives, fundraisers for local charities, tutoring and mentoring younger children, and volunteering at charity events in Macau. Enrollment and Curriculum

At the secondary level of SON, there are just over 100 students enrolled in Forms 3-6. Students in Forms 3 and 4 take part in Cambridge IGCSE courses. Coursework in the lower forms leads to enrollment in the IB Diploma Programme course of study in Form 5. , Kindergarten through Form 6. In May 2011, the first cohort of International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme students sat for the IB exams. All students in Form 5 &6 are enrolled in the international Baccalaureate course of study.
