As an integral component of the educational programs of the Badi Foundation, the School of the Nations is dedicated to nurturing the physical, intellectual and spiritual development of its students, and developing their capabilities to promote the well-being of their families and communities. ## Enrollment and Curriculum

At the secondary level of SON, there are just over 100 students enrolled in Forms 3-6. Students in Forms 3 and 4 take part in Cambridge IGCSE courses. Coursework in the lower forms leads to enrollment in the IB Diploma Programme course of study in Form 5. , Kindergarten through Form 6. In May 2011, the first cohort of International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme students sat for the IB exams. All students in Form 5 &6 are enrolled in the international Baccalaureate course of study.

## Extra curricula activities

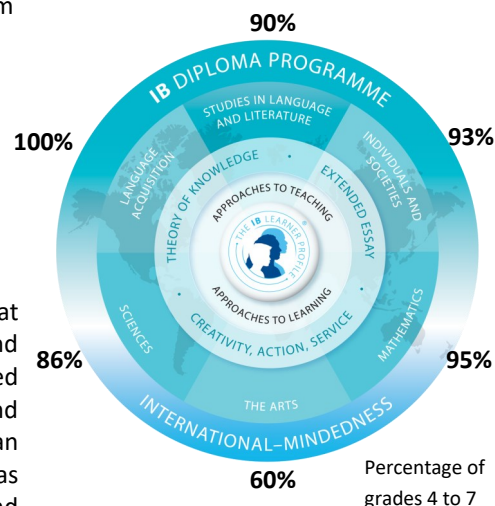
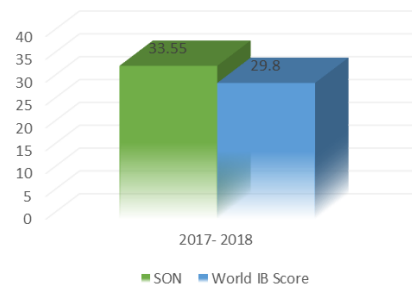
