As a K-12 English-medium instruction school, it is the first Cambridge International School as well as the first IB World School in the Macao Special Administrative Region of China.

In May 2011, the first cohort of IBDP students completed the program successfully and has subsequently continued to progress and go from strength to strength.



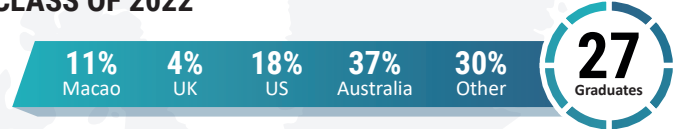
**CERTIFICATES**

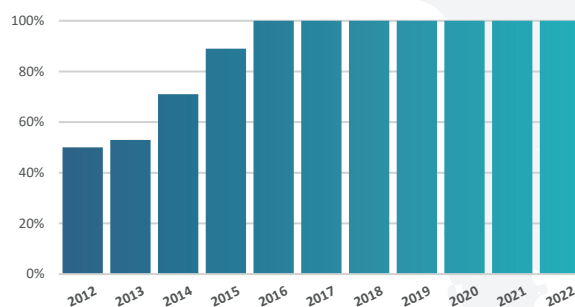

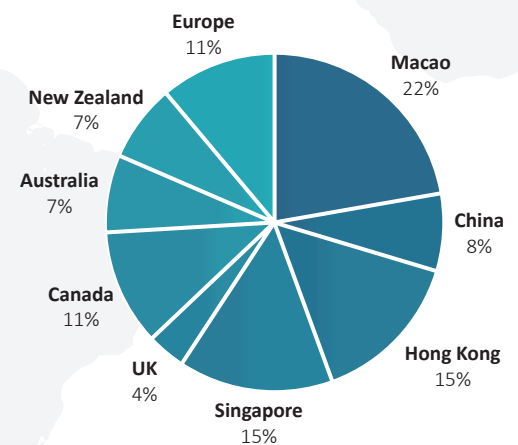

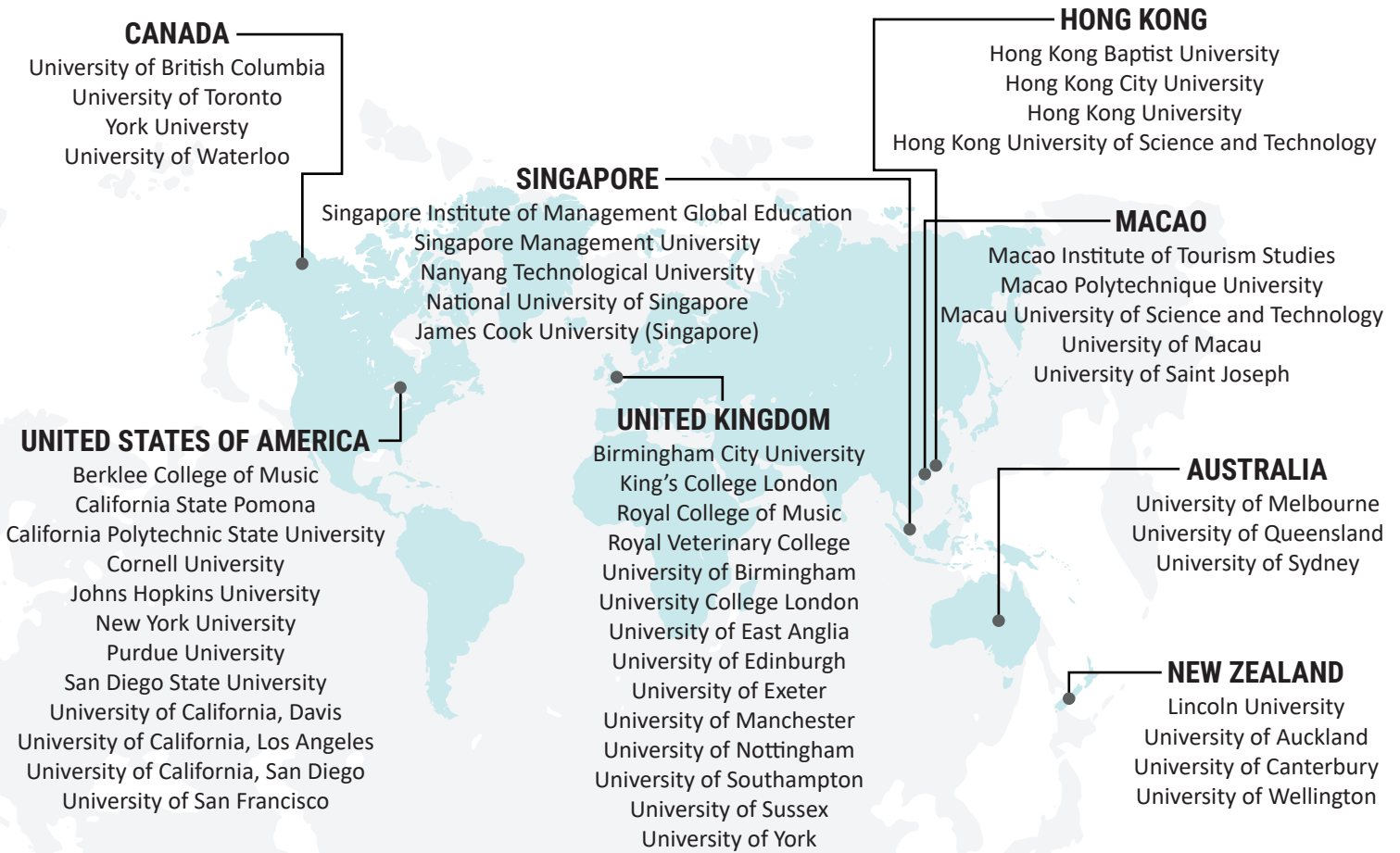
**2021 COHORT UNIVERSITY DESTINATION**
